This is a full time, fixed term position to ensure the delivery of professional services tailored to the needs of clients.

The aim of Not So Different is to increase awareness, knowledge and acceptance of neurodiversity (training) in the home, in schools and colleges, in the workplace and in the community as a whole. Increasing understanding of neurodiversity increases the capacity of those working with people who are neurodiverse to realise their full potential through education, training and employment. Working with individuals to improve their positive health and wellbeing through social inclusion and personal development is central to the work of Not So Different.

The Role and responsibilities of Programme Manager

Reporting to the Board, the Programme Manager and Neurodiversity specialist will be responsible for

 The management of the Neurodiversity Employment Programme including the assessment of eligibility and suitability of individuals to engage with the NSD Programmes. The role also require the completion of the initial screening followed by a skills audit.

















 Management of clients services of NSD to develop person centred employment supports tailored to the specific needs of individuals who are neurodiverse to access mainstream services. Working with clients on issues that related to neurodiversity, such as sensory processing disorder, dyslexia, dyspraxia, autism, Asperger, anxiety etc.

Essential Knowledge and Experience – Must be able to demonstrate the following:

- Minimum of 5 years' of senior management experience with a particular focus on social enterprise, neurodiversity and inclusion and business. Must have a proven track record working with people who are neurodiverse in individual and group settings.
- Proven track record in progression of people who are neurodiverse through education to employment, with experience of working with local service providers, employers, educators and funders. Experience of working on Ability Programme 2018 – 2021 would be an advantage
